


I hope to be able to offer first year Confirmation Classes beginning in September. So, if you are interested or know someone who is, please contact either myself or your Council President, Alice Diver.


I'm open to combining younger age students this year in order to keep students being the only student in their class. Please help to spread this announcement to people who you believe would be interested.


#### **Ladies Night Out**


